Bachelor of Studies in English (BS English) (5th Semester Induction)	1. Graduates with a minimum CGPA of 2.0 out of 4.0 or at lead 45% marks in a 2-year associate degree in English (semest system) are eligible to apply for direct admission into the 5 semester of the BS English, in accordance with HEC guideline and the university's admission policy. 2. All other students, including those with an ADP in English (annual system), ADP in non-English fields, or other equivale 14-year degrees (such as B.A./B.Sc.), are required to comple 18 credit hours of deficiency courses in a bridge semest (UGE-2023; National Education Framework-2015), approved by the departmental curriculum review committee. 3. 


